Personal Equipment Checklist

Packing

Check/Double Check

___ ___ Dry Sack (for keeping clothes and gear dry)

Approximate (2) 35 Liter or greater

Approximate (1) 55 Liter or greater

___ ___ 6-12 1-gallon Zip lock bags (to pack clothes)

Sleeping

___ ___ Sleeping bag with stuff sack (wrap in plastic bag before placing in outer bag)

___ ___ Sleep clothes – worn only in sleeping bag (t-shirt + gym shorts)

___ ___ Sleeping pad (closed foam or Therma-rest style)

Clothing (NO COTTON !)

(note need to have dry set of clothes)

Layer A (Canoeing clothes, wear 1 and pack set)

___ ___ Old Sneakers or water shoes

___ ___ 2 quick dry hiking shorts, pants (zip off) or bathing suit

___ ___ 2 short sleeve shirts (Polypropylene preferred)

___ ___ 1 hat – flexible with brim

Camp Clothes

___ ___ Camp shoes or sneakers (a dry pair)

___ ___ 1 or 2 pair of Synthetic socks

___ ___ Change of underwear (unless using shorts with mesh)

Layer B (cool evening)

___ ___ 1 long sleeve shirt (wool or acrylic)

___ ___ 1 pair of long pants

Layer C (cold)

___ ___ 1 sweater, light coat, or poly-fleece (no cotton)

___ ___ 2nd sweater, light coat or poly-fleece (no cotton) as dry backup

Layer D (cold, wet or windy)

___ ___ 1 Rain-suit (Jacket and pants)

Eating

___ ___ Bowl

___ ___ Cup (optional)

___ ___ Spoon

___ ___ 2-3 one-liter water bottles

Personal and Miscellaneous

___ ___ Small pocketknife (Totin' Chip required)

___ ___ Matches or lighter in waterproof container

___ ___ Headlamp (recommended) or small flashlight, with extra batteries/bulbs

___ ___ Map

___ ___ Compass

___ ___ Money (\$5-\$10 in small bills)

___ ___ Insect Repellent

___ ___ Soap, biodegradable

___ ___ Toothbrush

___ ___ Toothpaste

___ ___ Sunscreen (at least 15 SPF)

___ ___ Ditty bag (or Zip-loc bag) for personal items when stored in group Bear Bag
